**Amendment to the Bylaws Regarding the Special Conditions  
of Admission for Degree Programs in the Faculty of Business  
Administration (Hamburg Business School)  
dated 27 January 2016**

On 5 February 2018, in accordance with Section 108 subsection 1 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG) dated 18 July 2001 (HmbGVBl. p. 171) last amended on 28 November 2017 (HmbGVBl. p. 365), the University's Executive University Board ratified the Amendment to the Bylaws Regarding the Special Conditions of Admission for Degree Programs in the Faculty of Business Administration (Hamburg Business School) adopted by the Faculty of Business Administration's faculty council pursuant to Section 91 subsection 2 no. 1 HmbHG in accordance with Section 37 subsection 2 HmbHG.

### **Section 1**

The Bylaws Regarding the Special Conditions of Admission for Degree Programs in the Faculty of Business Administration dated 27 January 2016 are amended as follows:

In “B. Master’s degree programs 1. Master of Science in Business Administration (MSc),” sentence 4 will be replaced as follows:

“A degree program is deemed to be research and method-oriented in nature when applicants have completed lecture, practical, or seminar modules amounting to at least 24 ECTS credits in mathematics, statistics, and microeconomics.”

### **Section 2**

The change to the Bylaws Regarding the Special Conditions of Admission for Degree Programs in the Faculty of Business Administration becomes effective on the day after official publication. They first apply to students commencing their studies in Winter Semester 2018/19.
