Marie Curie Innovative Training Networks	<i>“Graduate Schools” of EU, funding for a max of 15 PhD students in a network</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Marie Curie rules for mobility apply – PhD students may not have lived or worked in country of host institution for more than 12 months in 3 years before project starts - common workshops and training of PhD students envisaged, students should get the chance to work in a different country or different sector (NGO, company ...) for some weeks or months during their PhD - one overall project purpose with different work packages
Marie Curie Individual Fellowships	<i>Postdocs work for 2 years in another European country</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Postdocs and projects should show excellence (already some publications, first knowledge in supervision of students or technicians) - during “fellowship” which actually is an employment at the host institution, the postdoc should get enough knowledge to climb a step further on the career ladder – maybe write own grants and after the fellowship establish a research group
European Research Council, ERC	<i>Research projects</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - for excellent individual scientists of all nationalities with research projects in Europe. - Starting Grants for young scientists (2 - 7 years after PhD) with up to 2 million euros over five years maximum - Consolidator Grants for young scientists (7 - 12 Years after PhD) with up to 2.75 million euros over five years maximum - Advanced Grants for experienced excellent researchers with up to 3.5 million euros over five years maximum <p>https://erc.europa.eu/funding-and-grants</p>
Collaborative projects on Societal Challenges (top-down)	<i>Collaboration of at least 3 partner institutions from 3 different EU or associated countries</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - development of solutions to identified problems in European society - strict guidelines to be followed, coordinator is main communicator to EU Commission and partner organisations - excellence, impact and implementation to be well defined for projects - “topics” announced in Participant Portal with deadlines within 6 months from announcement, time to grant reduced to 8 months after deadlines

	<i>International Scientific Events</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - international specialist conferences: integrative lecture event with a specific topic and focus on a European audience; a variant of the Gordon Conference - international congress, symposium, colloquia, workshop: International scientific event of particular significance for a specific subject area with a large number of participants from both Germany and abroad; - annual meeting: a regularly recurring meeting of a German specialist society, working group or specialist group; event of national significance with a clearly defined topic and international participation <p>http://www.dfg.de/en/research_funding/programmes/international_cooperation/international_events/index.html</p>
	<i>International Research Training Groups (Int. Graduiertenkollegs)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - joint doctoral training programs with a 6 months research stay at partner institution - posts for doctoral researchers and postdocs - grants and fellowships for doctoral researchers, postdocs, applicants holding a degree from a university of applied science (Fachhochschule) or a Bachelor's degree - funds for visiting researchers, research students, travel, workshops - funding period: 4.5 years; maximum funding duration: 9 years <p>http://www.dfg.de/en/research_funding/programmes/coordinated_programmes/research_training_groups/international_rtg/index.html</p>

PPP – Research Based Mobility Scheme	<i>PPP – Research Based Mobility Scheme</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to promote research collaboration between UHH and LU research groups - a joint scientific research project is required; open to all fields of study - travel grants over a period of one or two years as well as a daily lump sum

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Lecture tours and conference attendance	<i>Kongress-und Vortragsreiseprogramm</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - for UHH academics - travel and accommodation allowances
Guest lecturer program	<i>Gastdozentenprogramm</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - application made by UHH academics - LU academics can be invited for a lecture period between 3 and 12 months - 10 % of the funding is covered by the UHH Department of International Affairs
Internationalisation of courses	<i>Integrated international courses with double degrees</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - leads to a joint or a double degree - at least one year stay at the foreign partner university in undergraduate studies or at least one term of study abroad for master programs
	<i>(ISAP) International Study and Training Partnerships</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - groups of highly qualified German and foreign students can complete a fully recognized part of their studies at a partner university - agreement of credit transfer rules, joint curriculum development or the preparation of double degrees - ISAP should be applied in principle in the longer term
PhD in Germany	<i>Graduate School Scholarship Program (GSSP)</i>	-funding of up to three years, in the case of doctoral students from developing and emerging countries, up to four-year scholarships in doctoral programs at universities in Germany
Postdoc in Germany	<i>"Postdoctoral Researchers International Mobility Experience" (P.R.I.M.E.)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - all nationalities - funding of 18 months, of which the first 12 months should be spent abroad (period abroad) and the remaining six months in Germany (reintegration phase). - employment at the selected German host university for the whole funding period.
Summer Schools	<i>Summerschools abroad</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Enhanced positioning of individual German universities in the international education market -recruitment of highly qualified graduates for doctoral and master's programs in Germany -applications from individual German universities or their departments, institutes and university consortia
	<i>Summerschools in Germany</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - foreign students and doctoral courses at any seasons in Germany -professional training in current research and professional and cultural exchange between foreign and German participants -applications from individual German universities or their departments, institutes and university consortia

Scholarships provided by DAAD - Incoming	<i>Research Stays for University Academics and Scientists</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to carry out a research project at a university or non-university research institute in Germany for the duration of one to three months -foreign academics and scientists working in higher education or at research institutes
	<i>Research Grants for Doctoral Candidates and Young Academics and Scientists (short-term)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -to carry out a research project in Germany -doctoral candidates, young Post-Docs -living expenses, health insurance, travel lump sum -between one to six months
	<i>Research Grants for Doctoral Candidates and Young Academics and Scientists (long-term)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -to study or carry out a research in Germany -students; doctoral candidates -living expenses, health insurance, travel lump sum and subsidiary allowances -length of grant: one year
Scholarships provided by DAAD - Outgoing	<i>Short-term Scholarship for Doctoral Candidates</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -doctoral candidates from German Universities -living expenses, health insurance, travel lump sum, research allowance -grant for one to six months
