HOUSING SEARCH

Hamburg is divided into 7 districts: Hamburg-Mitte; Altona; Eimsbüttel; Hamburg-Nord; Wandsbek; Bergedorf; and Harburg. These districts are further subdivided into neighborhoods. Hamburg has a total of 104 neighborhoods.
