Universität Hamburg receives 1 million euros in funding for strategic partnerships

Universität Hamburg is one of a select few universities to receive around 1 million euros over the next four years via the German Academic Exchange Service's (DAAD) strategic partnership program to establish a strategic trilateral partnership with Fudan University in Shanghai (China) and Macquarie University in Sydney (Australia). This will enable Universität Hamburg to expand its cooperations with both universities.

In addition to internationalizing training for doctoral and master's students and establishing further dual and joint degree programs, the network aims to attract highly qualified early career researchers, to develop joint research projects with the partner universities, and to engage them in a joint initiative to develop international universities of the future.

When establishing such strategic partnerships, Universität Hamburg takes both institutional and individual aspects into consideration. Focused international exchange seeks to realize the declared aim of achieving education through science and research, and fostering openness, tolerance, and a consciousness for cultural identity among both teachers and students. After founding strategic partnerships with universities in Denmark, South Africa, and the USA, this trilateral academic partnership presents a further milestone in the ongoing internationalization of Universität Hamburg.
