DEGREE PROGRAM PREPARATION UP TO 12 BONUS POINTS

Grading scale: „very good“ = 1,0 - 1,5; „good“ = 1,6 - 2,5; „satisfactory“ = 2,6 - 3,5

- **FSP Assessment Test** at a state-accredited Studienkolleg in Germany with grade „very good“ = 3 points; „good“ = 2 points; „satisfactory“ = 1 point

or

- **Preparatory Pre-Semester** at Universität Hamburg with grade „very good“ = 3 points; „good“ = 2 points; „satisfactory“ = 1 point

or

- **Academic Studies at a public German university⁶** with minimum 30 ECTS and an average grade „very good“ = 6 points; „good“ = 4 points; „satisfactory“ = 2 points

⁶Successful completion of the trial studies at Universität Hamburg (plausibility checking procedure for refugees without complete documents) qualifies for up to six bonus points.

TestAS

- **Core test**,
as of a standard score: 106-111 = 1 point; 112-117 = 2 points; 118-130 = 3 points
- **Subject-specific score**,
as of a standard score: 106-111 = 1 point; 112-117 = 2 points; 118-130 = 3 points
- Conversion of points for the **digital version of the TestAS**:
130-159 = 1 point; 160-189 = 2 points; 190-200 = 3 points.

- Entitlement to asylum or subsidiary protection or recognition of refugee status.
