

Certification of General Languages

The certification of ECTS for students at University Hamburg requires:

- the attendance of 80% and the active participation in the class' activities,
- regular preparation and follow-up work and
- obligatory additional homework
- Furthermore, you have to achieve 60% on the exam sat at the end of the course.

If all these requirements are complied with, a certificate will be awarded to you.

The workload indicated in ECTS (*credits*) depends on the contact hours and the time provided for self-directed learning in accordance to the particular level of the language course. The following overview shows the amount of credits according to the level and the amount of contact hours of the individual course:

Note: The ECTS points are entered in STiNE upon presentation of the certificate via the examination office or the office of the respective department. The decision about the possibility of credit rests with the respective department.

For each language level credits are only awarded *once!*

Receiving a place in a course with a level significantly below the current, proven level of language proficiency is an exception that will only be approved after consultation or for valid reasons. Since it is a repetition or exercise, *no credits* can be earned for the course.

Rating/Grade

Your performance will be graded. Corresponding with the language level the final grade proportionally results from the grade you achieve on the written exam and the grade for self-directed work:

The grade and the credits are indicated on the certificate. A certificate without grade and credits is issued on demand only.
