Students apply for research projects of their choice

The interests of both, the PhD host and the student applicant are taken into account:

- The hosting institution is free to choose a topic of the internship in the fields of **Life Sciences, Photon & Neutron Science and Welfare State**.
- The applicant is free to choose only internships which correspond to their personal interests.
- The PhD students is free to choose only interns who correspond to their expectations.
- Both, the intern and their host are free to arrange the timing of the internship (it should be realized within the period of **1st June and 16th October 2020** and it should have a duration of **minimum 2 weeks and no longer than 12 weeks**).
