in the **Faculty of Business, Economics and Social Sciences** commencing as soon as possible, ref. no. 2308/W3.

### **Responsibilities:**

The successful candidate is expected to teach and conduct research in political science with a focus on comparative political institutions in Latin America. Outstanding accomplishments and extensive experience are expected with regard to innovative research on, e.g., constitutional reforms, presidentialism, inter-institutional relations, and judicial politics. The successful candidate will contribute to the broader research agendas of Universität Hamburg and GIGA in the thematic field of democratic institutions. Knowledge transfer activities and the assumption of coordinative responsibilities are also part of the tasks at GIGA.

As a professor of the Faculty of Business, Economics and Social Sciences, the incumbent will have teaching obligations of two teaching hours per week and examination duties.

Section 12 subsection 7 sentence 2 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG) applies.

### **Requirements:**

Academic qualifications and additional requirements as specified in Section 15 HmbHG.

### **Additional criteria:**

Candidates must have been accepted into the Leibniz Programme for Women Professors in order to apply.

Applicants are expected to have an international research profile with a track record of publications in leading peer-reviewed journals of political science and/or area studies. They are also expected to have international research experience as well as a successful track record in acquiring external funding and carrying out externally funded projects.

The University places particular emphasis on the quality of teaching and therefore requests that applicants provide details of their teaching experience and objectives.

Following hearings, selected candidates will be assessed to ascertain skills in the areas of management and human resources.

In accordance with Section 14 subsection 3 sentence 3 HmbHG, Universität Hamburg and GIGA seek to increase the proportion of women in teaching and research and encourage female academics to apply.

Qualified disabled candidates or applicants with equivalent status receive preference in the application process.
