The position commences on as soon as possible and is fixed for two years. The position is part-time at 19.5 hours per week.

Information on fixed-term contracts:

In accordance with Section 14 subsection 2 of the German part-time and fixed-term contract act (Teilzeit- und Befristungsgesetz, TzBfG), this position is exclusively open to applicants who have **not** been employed by the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg for more than three years.

Responsibilities:

The position is primarily tasked with theater production, but also requires scholarly research in the theater field. The position is assigned to Professor for British Studies Dr. Ute Berns. The key tasks involve leading the Theatre Workshop, organizational and commercial support, and artistic direction of one English-language theatrical production per semester as well as the publication of a program. The position is also required to cooperate with other institutions within the University as well as Hamburg schools.

Requirements:

an university degree in a relevant field with a clear focus on English drama and theater.

Required skills and personal qualities:

- hands-on experience in staging theatrical productions (production, dramaturgy, organization)
- native-speaker competence in English (experience with multiple native varieties preferred)
- experience in scholarly research
- exceptional organization skills

We explicitly encourage persons with an immigrant background to apply.
