The position in accordance with Section 28 subsection 3 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG) commences on 01.10.2020 and consists exclusively of teaching duties. The position calls for 39 hours per week. This position is also suitable for part time employment.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Duties consist solely of independent or supervised teaching. Teaching obligations are determined in accordance with current state regulations (Lehrverpflichtungsverordnung, LVVO). The LVVO permits the Office of the Dean to redefine the teaching obligation. Teaching duties currently comprise 16 teaching hours per semester.

### **SPECIFIC DUTIES:**

Teaching English at all levels on the BA, MA, BEd and MEd programs offered in English and American studies.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

A university degree in a relevant field. English language skills at CEFR C2 or native speaker level. Experience in university language teaching up to CEFR C2 level. Familiarity with the standards of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Good knowledge of German at least at CEFR level B2, which allows for participation in university committees. Extensive knowledge of central aspects of British and US-American regional studies with a focus on "political systems", "media landscape" and "media literacy" is an advantage. Also advantageous is a qualification in English language teaching (EFL/ESOL/EAP) as well as experience in course and curriculum development at university level and the use of digitally supported teaching and learning methods. Teamwork and creative problem-solving skills are expected.

Qualified disabled candidates or applicants with equivalent status receive preference in the application process.
