Where to find information

- Hamburg State and University Library
 - Resources from almost all scientific areas
 - Textbook collection with introductions and study literature
 - Most Books & journals have to be ordered first before lending
 - Specific materials about the Hamburg area
- Department libraries
 - Relevant resources for the needs of the faculty
 - Smaller Textbook collections
 - Specialised with high expertise
- Access anytime from home or abroad to our e-resources (books, journals, databases) from various scientific areas




The libraries

- Department libraries are spread over the whole city







Best-Match Method

Hits with high accordance will be ranked at the foremost results (Relevance-Ranking)

- Hits with partly according search terms are also found
- Leads to high sets of results

Fuzzy search

finds grammatically related terms

fuzzy search: search for library finds also the word libraries



Technology behind katalog**plus**


Exact Match – precise search term with exact matching results

Best match – KI aided enriched search with best results which match the search






Easy search

List of results: most common media










Refine search results

- Publishing year




Select different locations




- Results can be shown for specific libraries

Lending or use at the library?


Two kinds of media

- Holdings must be used within the library as reference holding / collection (Präsenzbestand)
 - Use of media at the library to scan, copy or take a picture
 - In some cases: Lending is allowed only for a short time
 - Older, rare or precious books will not be lend

- available for loan (ausleihbar)
 - Books can be borrowed to work with them at home
 - The usual loan period is 4 weeks with triple option to extend the return date depends on library rules


Helpful: table of contents

- You get a first hint if the book matches your search and is relevant for your task/research

- Results which you can access directly are shown (with some exemptions)



- Resources campus-only can be accessed, even abroad

- 1. Fill out the online form on our website
- 2. Bring your ID or passport (+ with proof of address, Meldebestätigung' and if necessary residence permit 'Aufenthaltstitel')
