Universität Hamburg invites applications for a Research Associate in accordance with Section 28 subsection 3 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG). The position commences on 1. Oct. 2018.

It is remunerated at the salary level TV-L 13 and calls for 39 work hours per week.

The fixed-term nature of this contract is based upon Section 2 of the academic fixed-term labor contract act (Wissenschaftszeitvertragsgesetz, WissZeitVG). The term is fixed for a period of 4 years.

The University aims to increase the number of women in research and teaching and explicitly encourages women to apply. Equally qualified female applicants will receive preference in accordance with the Hamburg act on gender equality (Hamburgisches Gleichstellungsgesetz, HmbGleIG).

Responsibilities:

Duties primarily include teaching and research. Research associates can also pursue independent research and further academic qualifications.

Specific Duties:

The duties are: Conceptualization and implementation of a web-based tool for the analysis of text variants in historical Arabic texts. This includes contributing to the development of a meta-data model together with a researcher from the humanities. Further duties are the technical supervision of the data ingest and maintenance of the created database during the duration of the position.

Requirements:

A university degree in a relevant field. Also necessary are: knowledge and familiarity with the Arabic Unicode block; knowledge of Arabic historical script; knowledge of markup languages such as XML and data standards; good communication skills; knowledge of English and Arabic; desirable further competences are programming skills in languages such as Python, Java or C++ as well as good knowledge of up to date web technologie and experience in web development

Severely disabled applicants will receive preference over equally qualified non-disabled applicants.
