Universität Hamburg invites applications for a Research Associate in accordance with Section 28 subsection 3 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG). The position commences on 15-05-2018 or later.

It is remunerated at the salary level TV-L 14 and calls for 39 hours per week.

The fixed-term nature of this contract is based upon Section 2 of the academic fixed-term labor contract act (Gesetz über befristete Arbeitsverträge in der Wissenschaft, WissZeitVG). The term is fixed to 30-06-2020.

The University aims to increase the number of women in research and teaching and explicitly encourages women to apply. Equally qualified female applicants will receive preference in accordance with the Hamburg act on gender equality (Hamburgisches Gleichstellungsgesetz, HmbGleIG).

Responsibilities:

Duties primarily include teaching and research. Research associates can also pursue independent research and further academic qualifications.

Specific Duties:

Principle Investigator leadership for two sub projects in the Collaborative Research Center "TRR 181", namely T3: "Energy transfers in gravity plumes" and L3: "Diagnosing and parameterising the effects of eddies" focusing on experimental oceanography. Supervision of postdocs and PhD in these sub projects and participation in ongoing ship cruises of the project. It is expected that the successful candidate will also participate in planing the proposal for the next phase of the TRR 181. The position also includes teaching duties at the equivalence of four hours per weeks during the teaching period.

Requirements:

A university degree in a relevant subject plus doctorate. Experience in experimental oceanography including participation in ship expeditions.

Severely disabled applicants will receive preference over equally qualified non-disabled applicants.
